- 2. Tender should be submitted complete in all respect along with documents and EMD.
- 3. Tenders will be opened in the presence of Tenderers /representatives who choose to attend in the chamber of Medical Superintendent.
- 4. Tender without documents as above/incomplete tenders are liable to be rejected.
- 5. Medical Superintendent reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without assigning any reason thereof.
- 6. All pages of the tender are to be numbered & stamped /signed.
- 7. In case of any dispute, the area of jurisdiction is to be Kollam only.

- 1. The investigation centre will do all the tests investigations mentioned therein for the period of one year from
- 2. The investigation centre will provide all the investigations as per tie up list on cashless basis to ESI beneficiaries. No registration fee or other fee whatsoever will be charged by the centre from the beneficiaries referred for tests/investigations.
- 3. The investigation centre will provide the investigation facility only to referred beneficiaries (As per proper prescription/ reference from the doctors of ESIC Hospital, Parippally).
- 4. Results will be furnished and issued to ESI beneficiaries as mentioned in the terms and conditions of the tender document.
- 5. The investigation centre agrees that any liability arising due to any default / negligence in providing proper medical services shall be borne, by the investigation centre which shall alone be responsible for that.
- 6. Appropriate action may be initiated by the ESIC on the basis of complaints, medical audit or inspections carries out by ESIC team.
- 7. Identity of the patient is to be confirmed in each cases before conducting the investigation with reference to the photo affixed identity card issued by the ESIC.
- 8. The investigation centre has to ensure that the reference for costly investigations (costing above Rs.3000/- each) are authenticated by the Medical Superintendent of the ESIC hospital, Parippally and that eligibility certificate has been produced in each cases.
- 9. The lab shall depute minimum one lab technician in the Hospital in order to draw the sample, label, collect and transport the samples to lab.
- 10. The establishment's personnel/staff supplied shall have to maintain strict discipline as per Hospital requirements and maintain absolute integrity at all times.
- 11. The investigation centre shall be solely responsible for the payment of remuneration and other benefits to the staff deputed.
- 12. The report should be made available in the hospital on the next working day before 1.00PM
- 13. In case of specialized investigations the report should be supplied within three days.
- 14. In case of imaging investigations like CT scan, MRI etc the report/result should be submitted within 24hours. However in case of urgent/emergency case the report should be given the same day.

- 15. The investigation centre has furnished a security deposit of Rs.20000/- No interest will be paid on the security deposit and this amount will be refunded only after satisfactory fulfillment of the contract by him and all accounts thereafter will be settled.
- 16. Any loss to the Hospital on account of non performance of the contract, deficiency in performance due to lack of quality, non performance in time or similar deficiencies, will be recovered from the establishment and contract shall be liable for cancellation & SECURITY DEPOSIT forfeited.
- 17. Cash bill for investigations are to be submitted by the centre on monthly basis. Bills are to be submitted with proper prescription / reference form with a copy of report.
- 18. Establishment should comply with all labour welfare enactments and other statutory provisions governing employment of persons, working hours, payment that shall be made to the centre each time.
- 19. Income Tax as per Rules shall be deducted wherever applicable from payment that shall be made to the centre each time.
- 20. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the investigation centers at all times to obtain, maintain and sustain the valid registration, recognition and high quality and standard of its services and to have all statutory and mandatory licenses., permits or approvals of the concerned authorities under or as per the existing laws.

21. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

The ESIC may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breech of agreement by written notice of default sent to the investigation centre terminate the agreement in whole or part.

- a. If the centre fails to provide any or all services specified in the Annexure to this agreement within the period of agreement, or within any extension thereof if granted by the ESIC pursuant to condition of Agreement or
- b. If the centre fails to perform any other obligations under the Agreement
- c. If the centre, in the judgment of ESIC has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in the Agreement.
- d. If the investigation centre is found to be involved in or associated with any unethical illegal or unlawful activities,

The agreement will be summarily suspended by ESIC without any notice and thereafter may terminate the Agreement, after giving a show cause notice and considering its reply if any , received within 10days of the receipt of show cause notice.

22. Miscellaneous

- 22.1. Nothing under this agreement shall be considered as establishing or creating between the parties any relationship of Master and Servant or Principal and Agent between ESIC and the investigation centre.
- 22.2. The investigation centre shall not represent or hold itself out as an agent of ESIC.

- 22.3. This agreement can be modified or altered only on written agreement signed by both the parties.
- 22.4. The investigation centre shall bear all expenses incidental to the preparation and stamping of this agreement.

Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to this agreement shall be sent to the other party in writing by registered post or by facsimile and confirmed by original copy by post to the other party's address as below:
