ORDER

- 1) University vide paper read (1) above, invited applications for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2021-22 from the colleges for courses affiliated to this University. The Principal, Govt Medical College, Kollam MM034, has submitted applications for the continuation of provisional affiliation for the year 2021-22 vide paper read (2) above.
- 2) On verification of the applications, it is found that the college has submitted necessary documents for continuation of provisional affiliation for the year 2021- 22. The inspection commission vide paper read (3) above, has submitted the inspection report after conducting inspection at the college. After verifying the inspection report, vide paper read (4) above, the Scrutiny Committee pointed out deficiencies in Faculty and Residents. These deficiencies were intimated to the college vide read(5) above and subsequently, The Principal submitted compliance report vide read (6) above. After examining the compliance report, the Scrutiny Committee and vide read (7) above, recommended for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation after conducting a surprise inspection and verification of facts. Accordingly a surprise inspection was conducted at the college and the inspection commission vide paper read (8) above, has submitted the inspection report. After verifying the inspection report, vide paper read (9) above, the Scrutiny Committee pointed out deficiencies of 3 professors, 4 Associate professors and 4 tutors and recommended for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to Govt Medical College, Kollam for the academic year 2021-22.
- 3) The College vide paper read (10) has obtained renewal permission from the National Medical Commission for the conducting 5th batch (2021-22 academic year) MBBS course with 100 seats. The National Medical Commission, vide letter No. MCI(34) (41)(Gen)-2020-Med./ 122175 dated 21.09.2020, has clarified that "The allocation of seats to implement the EWS quota has been done in pursuance of 103rd Amendment to the Constitution of India by the Central Govt. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. Accordingly, the provisions relating to renewal of permission for increase of Medical seats are not applicable for seats granted for the purpose of extending reservation under EWS category."



4)The 66th meeting of the Governing Council held on 16.11.2021, vide decision No.66.10(1) has decided to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Govt. Medical College, Kollam for the academic year 2021-22 vide paper read (11) above. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the said decisions of the Governing Council. In the circumstances continuation of provisional affiliation is granted to Govt Medical College,kollam-MM034 for conducting the following course with an annual intake of students mentioned against it during the academic year 2021-22.

The College shall rectify the faculty deficiencies (3 Professors in the departments of Pharmacology, Ophthalmology, Pulmonary Medicine, 4 Associate Professors in the departments of Ophthalmology, Pathology, Psychiatry, Radio diagnosis and 3 Tutors in the department of Pathology & 1 Tutor in the department of Community Medicine and submit the compliance report regarding the same to the University before the commencement of the next academic year.

The college shall comply the following general conditions scrupulously.

- Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
- In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2021-22. The college has to apply for
 continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with
 a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.
- The College should remit annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG course for the academic year 2021-22. The College shall produce the orders regarding the constitution of College Council for the academic year 2021-22 during the time of student data verification.
- Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
