**CIRCULAR**

**(General guidelines for students on re-opening of Government Medical College, Kollam)**

- It is decided to reopen the college on 01/01/2021. Classes will commence as scheduled below;
  - 01/01/2021 -2017 Batch
  - 11/01/2021 -2019 Batch
  - 15/01/2021 -2018 Batch
- All students are instructed to come with RT -PCR done within 72 hours of reporting to the institution.
- 2017 batch students should report on 30/12/2020 before 4.00 PM. 2019 batch students on 09/01/2021 and 2018 batch students on 13/01/2020 before 4.00 PM.
- RT-PCR result will be checked at the hostels and only negative students are allowed to enter in to the hostel.
- Day scholar students are permitted to come from home.
- Inside the campus they should follow the instructions given from the institution.
  1. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as possible.
  2. Use of face mask/face shield is mandatory.
  3. Frequent hand washing with soap or use of alcohol based hand sanitizer can be done wherever feasible.
  4. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed.
  5. System of self-monitoring of health by all and reporting of illness if present, at the earliest to the concerned authorities should strictly be followed.

6. Spitting is strictly prohibited.
7. Installation and use of Arogya sethu app is advised where ever feasible.
8. All programmes and extracurricular activities should be avoided where physical distancing is not possible.
9. Clean & Hygienic conditions to be maintained in all places.
10. The details of the persons to be contacted in case of any emergency should be given.
11. Visitors are not allowed in the hostels.
12. Gymnasium if used shall follow MOHFW guidelines.
13. Proper disposal of personal protection items should be followed in accordance with CPCB.
14. Students should wear ID cards.
15. Students will be given an orientation class before going to the clinical departments.
16. The instructions students should follow in the hostels will be provided.
17. Thermal scanning of all students will be made available.
18. Resident students should avoid or limit visit to the markets.
19. As far as possible, essential items will be made available in the campus.
20. Students should regularly sanitize their laptop and other media accessories.
21. Sharing of books and other learning materials should be discouraged.
22. An undertaking should be given by each student that he or she will obey instruction given from the institution.
23. Students may get RT PCR done from their nearest Government facility by producing this circular & ID card.

### General instructions for Hostel inmates

1. All students must bring an RT-PCR report done within 72 hours of reporting to the hostel.
2. Thermal screening of all resident students shall be ensured.
3. Students should wear masks at all times within the common areas of the hostel.
4. There shall be no overcrowding in common areas of hostel.
5. All the meals shall be had in their respective rooms only. Hostel inmates to use own plates and glass for the same and not to be shared.
6. Students shall confine themselves in their hostel rooms.
7. Prior permission to be sought from warden before leaving the hostel premises.
8. Symptomatic students will not be permitted to stay in hostel under any circumstances.
9. There shall be no crowding in hostel areas where students share common facilities and utilities.
10. All programmes and extracurricular activities where physical distancing is not possible shall be avoided.
