University vide paper read (1) above, invited applications for continuation of provisional affiliation for the academic year 2020–21 from the affiliated colleges. The Principal, Govt Medical College, Kollam MM034, vide paper read (2) above, has submitted application for continuation of provisional affiliation for MBBS course with an intake of 110 seats for the academic year 2020-21.

2.0n verification of the application, it is found that the college has submitted necessary documents and remitted required fee for continuation of provisional affiliation for the year 2020-21. The inspection commission, vide paper read (3) above, has submitted inspection report after conducting inspection in the college. The Scrutiny Committee, vide paper read (4) above, after verifying the inspection report, has recommended to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Govt Medical College, Kollam for the academic year 2020-21.

The College vide paper read (5) has obtained renewal permission from the Medical Council of India for the conducting 4th batch (2020-21 academic year) MBBS course with 100 seats. The Medical Council of India, vide letter No. MCI(34) (41)(Gen)-2020-Med./ 122175 dated 21.09.2020, has clarified that "the allocation of seats to implement the EWS quota has been done in pursuance of 103rd Amendment to the Constitution of India by the Central Govt. - Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. Accordingly, the provisions relating to renewal of permission for increase of Medical seats are not applicable for seats granted for the purpose of extending reservation under EWS category."

The Governing Council, vide paper read as (6) above, has decided to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Govt Medical College, Kollam - MM034 for the academic year 2020-21. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the said Governing Council decision.

- 4. The college shall comply the following general conditions scrupulously.
 - Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
 - 2. In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c) 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
 - 3. Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2020–21. The college has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.
 - 4. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
 - 5. The College shall produce the orders regrading the constitution of College Council for the academic year 2020–21 during the time of student data verification.
 - 6. College should rectify the faculty deficiencies (one Associate Professor in Physiology, one Associate Professor in Biochemistry, one Professor in Pharmacology, one Professor in Paediatrics, one Associate Professor in Psychiatry, one Associate Professor in Ophthalmology, one Professor in Anaesthesiology, one Associate Professor in Radiodiagnosis, one Professor in Dentistry) and should submit the compliance report regarding the same to the University.
